BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETINGS ARE GOVERNED BY PUBLIC ACT 267.

Any citizen wishing to present to the Board of Education a complaint concerning a student or any member of the school personnel staff must normally have discussed the problem and the individual with his/her immediate supervisor and the Superintendent.

If further action is still requested, the Board will discuss the complaints in executive session, and final directives and actions will be held in public session.

The individual(s) charged with complaints will be given, upon request, an opportunity to explain, in public or private session, their actions or point of view concerning the complaints prior to any final directions or findings of the Board of Education.
