

ATTENTION 12th grade SENIORS! Class of 2024 Parents/Families: Michigan Achievement Scholarship

All Michigan high school seniors can be considered for the Michigan Achievement Scholarship, which provides financial assistance for college or career training programs. Depending on the post-secondary path, the scholarship could provide up to \$27,500. 7 out of every 10 students in the state may qualify for the Michigan Achievement Scholarship and students become eligible simply by completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). 

Michigan Lt. Gov. Garlin Gilchrist II joined the Michigan Department of Lifelong Education, Advancement, and Potential (MiLEAP) kicked off "Reach for the Pie," a statewide initiative and contest, in partnership with Hungry Howie's and Michigan Credit Union League, encouraging students and parents to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) to lower the cost of college and unlock valuable financial aid opportunities such as the Michigan Achievement Scholarship.

By completing the FAFSA, class of 2024 students will be eligible to enter the contest for a chance to win free Hungry Howie's pizza for a year. The prize will be awarded to 100 randomly selected students. The deadline to enter the contest is June 30, 2024. MiLEAP's MI Student Aid will post the list of winners on <u>reachforthepie.org</u> on or after Aug. 1, 2024.
