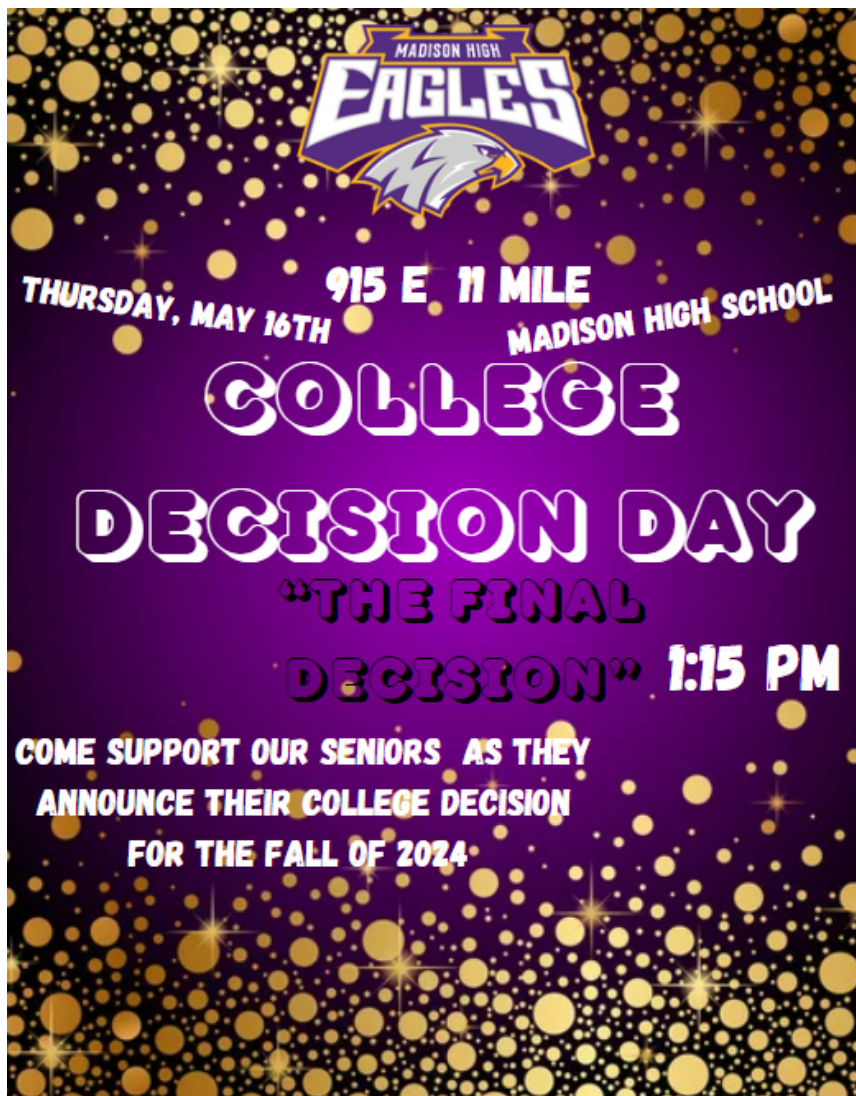
## College & Career Readiness Corner 🎓👜🏫

**ATTENTION 12th grade SENIORS! Class of 2024 Parents/Families:  
Michigan Achievement Scholarship**

All Michigan high school seniors can be considered for the Michigan Achievement Scholarship, which provides financial assistance for college or career training programs. Depending on the post-secondary path, the scholarship could provide up to \$27,500. 7 out of every 10 students in the state may qualify for the Michigan Achievement Scholarship and students become eligible simply by completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). ## Lunchtime Tutoring

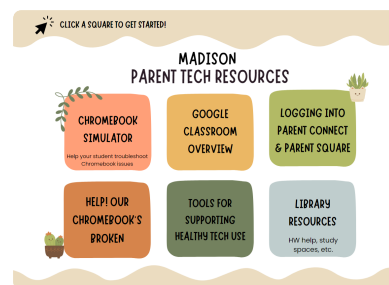
