MHS Building and Classroom Expectation Reminders



<u>Cell Phones:</u> In order to maximize learning opportunities, students

are expected to power off or silence and put away cell phones at the start of every class. If students fail to comply, a discipline referral will be submitted.

Attendance and Tardies: Regular attendance will allow students to succeed academically. If a student is going to be absent, be sure to contact the school attendance line to provide an explanation. Whenever possible, please also bring written documentation upon return to school. Being prompt and prepared for each class every hour is imperative!

The MHS Tardy Policy is as follows:

1-4 tardies = warning

5-7 tardies = lunch detention

8-10 tardies = after school detention + loss of privileges (field trips, clubs, athletics etc)

11-12 tardies = ISS

13+ tardies = OSS and Oakland County Attendance Officer referral


