I hope this letter finds you and your family well. As we prepare for the upcoming school year 2024-2025, I wanted to inform you about an important change regarding student transportation. Due to changes with the transportation policy, the school district has made the difficult decision to discontinue bus services for high school students living in Madison Heights starting this school year. We understand that this change may pose challenges for many families, and we want to provide you with ample time to make alternative transportation arrangements for your students.

We encourage parents and guardians to consider the following options:

- Carpooling with other families in your neighborhood.
- Walking or biking to school if it is safe and feasible.
