## **Manufacturing Day**

Today, our Eagles attended Manufacturing Day to receive a close-up look at the jobs of engineers, technicians, skilled trade employees and support staff during a three-hour tour. At AirBoss Engineering



we stepped into design labs, testing centers, production pods and other manufacturing environments during the tours.

Oakland County Manufacturing Day marks its 10th anniversary this year, with 1,000 students from 28 high schools and four technical campuses set to visit 34 advanced manufacturing facilities on Friday, Oct. 4.

Since 2015, more than 10,000 students have participated in Oakland County Manufacturing Day. The event has involved 103 companies, which have hosted tours to give students a firsthand look at modern manufacturing operations and potential career paths.

Our Eagles learned a ton and it sparked much interest in their future careers beyond high school!

\*FAFSA: Colleges and career schools use the FAFSA form to determine how much financial aid your student is eligible to receive, which could include grants, scholarships, and loans. While the window for completion does not open until December 1st, creation

\*Michigan Achievement Scholarships: These scholarships are designed to help recent high school graduates in Michigan receive funds for continuing education. Eligible students could receive financial aid to attend a college or university with the Michigan Achievement Scholarship, or for a career training program with the Michigan Achievement Skills Scholarship.
